 - d) Exchange of periodicals and academic publications
 - e) Undertaking joint R&D projects and other ventures
 - f) Registration of patents/ IPRs for the product jointly developed
 - g) Organization of joint workshops, symposia and conferences
 - h) Other academic exchanges agreed to by both universities
- 2. The implementation of each specific exchange based on this MoU shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions. Efforts shall be made by both sides to find financial sources for carrying out the exchange programs.
 - 3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by either, upon the other in carrying out the MoU.
 - 4. This MoU will be valid for five years and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the MoU at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties. This MoU shall take effect from the date of latest signature below.

Whereas:

The Regional cum Facilitation Centre (RCFC NRNR-1) of National Medicinal Plants Board Ministry AYUSH Govt of India situated at Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar (Mandi) and Eternal University agree to establish comprehensive research cum-academic partnership based on the principle of reciprocity. This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) aims at promoting the exchange of faculty, scholars, students, academic information, research materials and protocols with the

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commitment and understanding that the educational research and development process at both (The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The RCFC NR-1 at Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar will be carried forward and that mutual collaboration and interaction between their respective scientists, scholars and students will be synergized by the establishment of such exchange.

ARTICLE-I: SCOPE OF THE MOU

1

This MoU details the modalities and general conditions regarding collaboration between Department of Botany. Eternal University and RCFC NR-1 prompting cultivation and conservation of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants through community based organisations, Institutes of Local self-Governance, enhancing their capacities through trainings, enhancing co-operation and collaboration of highly qualified manpower in the areas of Herbal Exploration (Medicinal and Aromatic Plants) and Formulation Research without any prejudice to the prevailing rules and regulations in Eternal University and RCFC NR-1 without any disregard to any mechanism evolved and approved by the competent authorities. The areas of co-operation can be extended through mutual consent. Both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and RCFC NR-1 shall encourage interactions among the Administrator, Engineers, Scientists, Faculty members, Research fellows, Students and will help each other in solving various problems associated with testing, analysis and standardization of various products.

ARTICLE-II: SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

Both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and RCFC NR-1shall encourage interactions among the Scientists, Research fellows, Faculty members and Students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- a) Joint exploration and evaluation of medicinal and aromatic plants of the selected regions.
- b) Development of Nutraceutical, food and Ayurvedic formulations.
- c) Isolation, purification and identification of phytoconstituents for health benefits.
- d) Exchange and sharing of materials and expertise.
- e) Joint training of faculty and students of both institutes.
- f) Joint patenting, sharing and protection of IPRs.
- g) Exploration of the nutraceutical, healthcare and wellness potential of medicinal and aromatic plants of India.
- h) Undertaking joint R&D projects to develop novel healthcare and wellness formulations.
- i) Establishment of pilot plants for scaling up of lab scale protocols to commercial ventures.
- j) Maintenance, multiplication and regular supply of formulation materials and ingredients in large quantities.



- k) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective organization, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- I) Organization of joint meetings, conferences and seminars.
- m) Practical training of The Department of Botany, Eternal University students/faculty at RCFC NR-1.
- n) Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in different areas of research of state and national interests at The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar on mutually agreeable terms.
- o) RCFC NR-1 would accommodate The Department of Botany, Eternal University students who will have to complete their programme in such a number that deems convenient to it for the purpose of imparting industrial training.
- p) RCFC NR-1 may depute its personnel as visiting faculty at The Department of Botany, Eternal University to teach any of the specialized topics.
- q) RCFC NR-1 personnels, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their Ph.D. (as part time student) at Eternal University, subject to availability of seats, research facilities after the fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of Eternal University. Further, RCFC NR-1 may prepare to design and teach a Course which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.
- r) RCFC NR-1 may seek assistance/guidance of The Department of Botany, Eternal University faculty member/s in product, process modification, modernization, troubleshooting etc. Would allow the industrial visits of students to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instruments etc.
- s) RCFC NR-1 Joginder Nagar may showcase its business activities at the seminar/workshop/conference etc. at The Department of Botany, Eternal University. The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at the Eternal University.
- t) Post-graduate students will be allotted a Research supervisor from The Department of Botany, Eternal University faculty members. A Research Scientist/Engineer at RCFC NR-1 may be appointed a Co-research guide as per the rules of the respective organization for a student registered for Ph.D. (Regular or Part Time) degree at Eternal University. The student maybe encouraged to take up the project such that Industry (RCFC NR-1) desirably benefits from its outcome.

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- J The students will carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or M.Sc./Ph.D. projects at The Department of Botany, Eternal University and RCFC NR-1 depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective organization depending on facilities and requirements.
- v) There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- w) Both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and RCFC NR-1 will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this MoU. If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc., by both the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- x) Research supervisors from both the organization will be the corresponding authors in any publication resulting from the collaborative work. All the efforts put by the student/s as a part of this MoU will be accounted for by way of reporting the work in thesis and/or paper publication except the part for which IPR needs be claimed.
- y) Neither of the supervisors will publish the work carried out under this MoU without knowledge of the other.
- z) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall make provisions to share their respective important R&D facilities in order to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of co-operation.
- b) The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall permit the sharing of Labs and other materials and components developed inhouse in the areas of co-operation, if permissible within the rules governing the two institutions. However, responsibility for safety and other materials during the exchange will rest on respective Head of academic department/section.



c) The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall provide access to the library facilities to scientists, members of faculty and students as per the prevailing rules and norms in the respective institutes.

ARTICLE-IV: CO-ORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) The collaborative programme between The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall be coordinated by a coordination committee appointed by heads of both the organization.
- b) Financial arrangements for each specific collaboration will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from heads of both the Institutions.

ARTICLE-V: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MoU

- a) This MoU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MoU shall be for a period of 5 years from the effective date.
- c) During its tenancy, the MoU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than six months by either party. However, termination of the MoU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted to pursue a programme under the MoU.
- d) Any clause or article of the MoU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar.

ARTICLE-VI: IPR

Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, ownership of software/design/product developed etc. under the scope of this MoU, shall be decided by the two parties by mutual consent.

ARTICLE-VII: CONFIDENTIALITY

- a) During the tenure of the MoU both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MoU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MoU.
- b) Both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or projects.

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c) Further both The Department of Botany, Eternal University and The Research Institute in ISM, Joginder Nagar shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION shall mean any proprietary information, data or facts belonging to parties collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions.

Undertaking collaborative research activities through participation in (iii) nationally and internationally funded projects.

Jointly organize events such as seminars, workshops, conferences and (iv) training programs

Training of students of both institutions as per the facilities and resources (V) available

Any other objective as agreed upon in writing by both the institutions (vi)

Both parties acknowledge and understand that all financial arrangements, if any, 2. will be subjected to prior written agreement and availability of funds for each activity/project undertaken.

The MoU remains in place for a period of five years from the date of signing of the 3. agreement and may be renewed for a further period of five years or such time period as may be agreed upon by both the parties in writing.

No party shall have the right to use the name or logo of another party without the 4. prior approval of that party in writing.

The terms of this MoU may be modified/amended at any time subject to mutual

5. written agreement Such modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which both the parties execute them in writing.

The MoU may be terminated by either party by giving 3 months written notice. In 6. the event of termination, both the parties shall ensure that the interests of students/ongoing projects under this MoU are safeguarded to the extent possible.

Responsibilities of the Parties

Both parties mutually agree to identify various areas of interest and depute faculty/staff as per the requirements with mutual consent. The inviting institution shall meet the travelling expenditure and any honorarium/remuneration as may be applicable. The inviting institution shall make necessary boarding and lodging arrangements for the deputed person.

Both the institutions shall identify for accomplishing the above laid down objectives. Each party shall attempt to make such faculty available as and when required.

Both the institutions shall organize regular faculty interactions/meets to promote research interaction and collaboration among their faculty members. These meets may be organized for entire institute or specific to any department or school as per mutual convenience.

Every individual research collaboration will have separate agreement/terms of contract that addresses issues such as Intellectual Property Right (IPR), funding pattern, disclosure of confidential information etc.

In the event of any dispute or difference arising in the implementation of the MoU, such disputes shall be resolved amicably by mutual discussions by the signatories (or any higher officials deputed) of both the institutions. All such decisions shall take into account the status of students/ongoing projects under this arrangement and the interest of such students/projects shall be guarded as much as possible.

Activity agreements will include such terms as the following:

 - Specific schedules for the activity
 - Budgets and sources of finances for the activity
 - Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publications
 - Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity
- 3.4. Any arrangements subsequent to or as a result of the cooperation and activities stated in this clause shall be detailed in a separate agreement as deemed necessary.

4. Costs

- 4.1. The terms of co-operation and the necessary budget for each programme and activity implemented under the terms of this MOU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of any specific activity or project
- 4.2. Financial aspects shall be negotiated on an annual basis

5. Communication between the institutions

- 5.1. Both parties shall communicate with each other on a need's basis, through their coordinators, Prof. Dr. Ashutosh Tiwari, Chairman and Managing Director, VBRI and Prof. H.S. Dhaliwal, Vice Chancellor at Eternal University.





The Army will nominate one officer as their representative for co-ordinating the activities relating to the admission of Army personnel. He will liaise with the University personnel dealing with admission.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

13. The Army and EU agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, intellectual property rights that result from collaborative research or any activity under this MoU will be worked out on case-to-case basis and consistent with IPR policies of both the parties and the laws in force governed by security considerations and will be preferably arrived at through an agreement prior to commencement of any specific project/program.

COORDINATION

14. Eternal University shall identify one member of its faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Similarly, the Army will identify one serving officer to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, an Empowered Committee, to be co-chaired by the Nominee of the GOC-in-C, Army Training Command and the Vice Chancellor, EU and additionally consisting of (a) one or more nominees of Vice Chancellor, EU, (b) one or more nominees of the GOC-in-C, Army Training Command (c) Programme Coordinator from the side of the Army, and (d) Programme coordinator from the side of EU, will work out the details of programmes, and other forms of engagement, identified above. The same committee will periodically review existing programmes, as also identify and implement new programmes, to strengthen cooperation between the two organizations.

CONFIDENTIALITY

15. Each organisation undertakes that it will not at any time use, divulge or communicate to any person, except to its professional representatives or advisers or as may be required by law or any legal or regulatory authority, any confidential information concerning the business or affairs of the other organisation which may have come to its knowledge as a result of entering into this memorandum and each of the organisation shall use its reasonable endeavours to prevent the publication or disclosure of any confidential information concerning such matters, in any medium whatsoever.

DATE OF EFFECT AND TERMINATION

16. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two organizations. It will remain valid for five years and may be renewed after suitable review thereafter. Either organisation may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the organisation three months in organisation may commended, neither the Army nor EU will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other organization may suffer as a result. However, the Army and EU or outerwise, which are allowed to be completed successfully.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

17. Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic and research cooperation, the GOC-in-C, Army Training Command, or his nominee and Vice Chancellor, EU or his nominee will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

APPROVAL

- 18. This MoU is subject to the approval of the competent authorities of both the parties and also subject to the relevant laws of the land. The approval would be deemed to be in place once the MoU is signed.
- 19. Any new proposal if jointly accepted will be appended as addendum to this MoU.

TERMINATION

20. Either party shall be entitled to terminate this MoU by providing the other party with three calendar months advance notice. The termination of the MoU, for whatever reason, will not affect the rights of either party, which may have been secured as on the date of termination and will further not affect any rights, which specially or by their nature survive the termination of this MoU.

- a. A. PREAMBLE

Akai University, Talwandi Sabo (Receivathy referred to an WUTE on the context permits)

A. OBJECTIVES

The goal of this cooperation is to toster and development of academic and research collaboration between the two universities to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit and frequent immedian. EUBS and AUTS agree:

- t. To facilitate exchange of faculty and staff for the purpose of education and/or research.
- To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes as per national priorities; sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- To exchange the information on research and educational programmes, teaching, learning material and other literature, with due approval of the competent authority of both the organizations.

- To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students/scholars for limited periods of time for purpose of education and/or research.
- To encourage any other academic/research activities that both the institutions agreed to be mutual benefit.

EUBS and AUTS agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be expectely determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

The two universities hereby agree on the following articles to establish the Exchange Programme:

B. STUDENT EXCHANGE

- The aim of the exchange program is to provide students an opportunity to have experience of cooperation and exchange.
- The term of study for exchange students participating in this program shall be one academic semester, but may be extended with the consent of both universities.
- The number of students exchanged under the MoU shall be not more than three students at each university. The total number of mutual exchange students will be about same from each university during the term of five years.
- The host university has the right to decide acceptance of exchange students, by taking account of recommendation issued from the home university for exchange students based on their scademic record.
- 5. The host university will waive application fees, entrance fees, and tutton fees of the exchange students, transportation, accommodation, food, clothing and other personal costs including the medical health insurance and medical care will be the personal responsibilities of the students themselves. However, the host university may charge an amount for providing laboratory, library, internet facilities etc. The amount will be interested at the time of making other.

- The host university shall reserve or make evaluate accommodation on campus for exchange students or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.
- The exchange student is treated as either the research student or specially registered student.
- The exchange students will be subject to the student rules at the host university, while on exchange. Exchange students will be offered the same facilities as local students.
- Exchange students will study subjects or conduct researches which are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host university.
- 10. The acceptance of course work (lectures, seminars) taken at the heat university and the measure of achievement attained there will be communicated to the home university.
 - 11. Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two universities.

C. FACILITY EXCHANGE

- The two universities will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutual exceed periods.
- Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-time and long term visits of faculties, joint research and development projects.
- Encouragement of the academic feculty to co-author publications, joint research activities and joint project possibilities is in subject to applicable copyright and/or other laws of the country, as well as rules and regulations of the perspective universities.
- 4. The host university will endeavour to, as much as possible, make available such facilities that will anable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes, including the use of its laboratories and libraries.
- The two universities acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel, living and allied costs will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home university.
- Any intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two universities.

D. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

information will be actively exchanged, including information for students, information on research and study provided at the university, relevant information about faculty members and fields of research and university publications.

E. JOINT CONFERENCES, WORKSHOPS AND SHORT-TERM COURSES

EUBS and AUTS agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the invited faculty member(s) and the institution extending such an invitation. When a faculty member visits the other institution on invitation or as part of such joint activity/research project, then such a visit will be classified as such, and handled as per rules of the individual institution.

F. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

EUBS and AUTS agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-to-case basis by the competent authorities of both the institutions, and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutes.

G. TERMS OF IMPLEMENTATION, RENEWAL, REVISION, CANCELLATION AND NOTICES

- 1. This MoU becomes effective on the day it is signed and remains valid for five years.
- This MoU will be renewed after five years upon the consent in writing of both universities. Each university may cancel the MoU by notifying the other University of its intent to do so at least six months in advance of its expiration. Project in progress at the time of farmination will remain unaffected.
- Any amendment or modifications to the present text shall be submitted for review to the competent authorities, and shall not binding unless reduced to writing and signed by both the universities.

H. SIGNED IN DUFLICATE

This MoU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the institutes, acting by their duty authorised officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.

Memorandum of Understanding Between

ETERNAL UNIVERSITY and KALGIDHAR SOCIETY, BARU SAHIB

Eternal University Baru Sahlb, Himachal Pradesh, (hereafter referred to as the first party or 'EU') duly represented by its coordinator of certification course on Geriatric Care Assistant sponsored by Kalgidher Society and established by Act No. 3 of 2009 by the Himachal Pradesh Government, is one of the few private universities in the world committed to value based higher scientific and technical education. The Biernal University with its seven constituent colleges viz., Akal College of Engineering & Technology, Akal College of Basic Sciences, Akal College of Arts and Social Sciences, Akal College of Health and Allied Sciences, Akal College of Education and Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College Agriculture has been duly recognized by UGC, AICTE, DIC, NCTE, DSIR, DBT and DRDO for undertaking diverse teaching programs, research, and extension activities. It has been accordited by NAAC. The Elemal University is offering nearly 60 undergraduates to Ph. D. programs in its seven constituent colleges.

AND

The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib hereinafter referred to (As Second Party) and duly represented by its Authorized Signatory, Mr. Darshan Singh.

The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib is a non-profit charitable organization focusing on providing quality education to fight against the alarming rise in drugs and alcohol abuse with equal
stress on Healthcare, Woman Empowerment and Social Welfare, the organization has been
instrumental in the socio-economic uplift of the poor in the far-flung rural areas of North India. Today the rural areas of Utter Pradesh, Haryana and Rajasthan, and the backward hilly
areas of Himachal Pradesh and Pusjab are dotted with 129 low cost CBSE Schools, providing
modern, value-based education to around 70,000 students. The students are mostly from the
deprived sections of society, admitted regardless of caste, creed, region, religion and social
status. The aim is to build a total of 500 low-cost schools to provide value-based education to
all children at the village level. The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib also runs 24 Colleges, two
Private Universities, six Teachers Training Centres to empower 2000 rural girls, one Hospital
with 280 bods, three De-addiction Centres, one Orghanage, one Old Age Home, and one





Rehabilitation Centre for Distressed Women, apart from organizing four Free Medical/Surgery Camps for the poor in the hilly areas of Sirmaur, Himnehal Prodesh.

SCOPE

The scope of this cooperation between the Kalgidhar Society and EU is to promote and facilitate the view of sharing a Common desire to explore extend and strengthen the mutual relationship with well-established academic and Research & Development set up in order to share the facilities and expertise available with each of them to offer practical training to EU trainees for Geriatric care assistance.

COORDINATION

- EU is starting an add on certificate course in "Geriatric Care Assistant "for axisting girl students pursaing graduation and also for 12th standard pass students
- For the above course, the students are required to undergo practical training by Visiting Senior care home/ Old age homes.
- The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib under its various activities and program also include "Home for Senior Citizens".
- At present more than 50 volunteers above 60 years of age are residing and spending their second innings at Baru Suhib by engaging in Voluntary activities according to their capabilities.
- More than 20 volunteer above 70 years are residing and their daily needs including boarding lodging and medical needs are being looked after by the society.
- Through this MOU, the Kalgidhar society agrees in Principle to allow the Trainees from Eternal University to get practical training for "Geriatric care assistant" under the condition that they will abide by the norms and regulations of the society.
- The detail schedule of the program and posting will be intimated to the society in advance and the students will work under the supervision of Teachers only after taking due permission from the concerned authorities.

The MoU is valid for a period of five years from the date of signature by both the parties and may be renewed for any other period as shall be agreed on in between the parties. If either Party does not wish to continue this MoU, then such Party provide the other Party of its intention to terminate this MoU, by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing.

This Memorandem of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MeU) is made on this day of the swenth of July in the year 2021 by and between the ICAR-National Bureau of Agriculturally Important Microorganisms having its Head Office at Kushmaur, Max Nath Bhojan-275103 Uttar Pradesh [hereinafter called First party], a constituent Research Institution of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi-110001 on the ONE PART and the Eternal University having its headquarters at Baru Sahib, District Sirmour (H.P.) 173101 (hereinafter called Second party) on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).

The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality postgraduate research in cutting edge areas in accordance with the provisions contained in the Guidelines issued wife Letter No. 2-8/201 2- HRD dated 11' December, 2012 or as revised from time to time.

AND WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties.

Article 1. Scope

1.1 The Second party will recognize the First party as an Institute for conducting research related to the thesis requirement of the research students for various fields of Agricultural Sciences and Basic Sciences. The Second party will recognize Scientists of the ICAR Institute as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for nuiding students working for the said degree.

1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research programmes and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines /divisions. The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from a Second

party outside NARS should be exclusively different as far as possible.

1.3 Research irotromestation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the respective organizations.

1.4 There shall be an exchange of students for academic, research and training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

Article 2. Management

- Director of the First party and the Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.2 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the students, faculty and scientists.

Article 3. Exchange of Information

3.1. The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or unsing under project descriptions entered into pursuant to this MoU.

3.2. The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.

Article 4. General Provisions

4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students which violate principles of non-discrimination

43 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the

4.4 Any research publications urising will be jointly published in accordance with the provisions loid out in Item 3.2.10 of the Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programme as trainees at ICAR Institutions as notified vide Letter No. 2- 8/20 12-H RD dated 11st December, 2012 or revised guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time.

4.5 A copy of the thesis/dissertation will be submitted to the First Party after the award of the

degree by the Second party.

4.6 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which on arbitratur of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.

4.7 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual

4.8 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the

Article 5. Intellectual Property Rights

5.1 The Second party will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Hights generated or likely to be generated during the student's research work. The ICAR as the first applicant (for its institute) and the Second party shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the students and involved scientific staff shall be included as the inventor/breeder/author. The ICAR Guidelines for Intellectual Property Management and Technology Transfer/Commercialization as amended from time to time shall be the reference for exploitation of the generated intellectual property, whose management and benefits sharing shall be mutually decided in each case.

Article 6. Admission and Fires

- 6.1 All those who wish to register as trainers or for Master/ Doctoral programme under this MoU must apply for admission at the Second party. The allocation of Major Guide/Advisor would be finalized before the registration and will be governed by the provisions laid out in items 3.2.1A and 3.2.2A of the Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programmes as trainees at ICAR institutions as notified vide Letter No. 2-8/2012-HSD dated 11" December, 2012 or revised Goldelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time, for the students from within NARS and outside NARS, respectively.
- 6.2 Admission of the students and the award of degrees for different programmes will be the responsibility of the Second party as per the rules and regulations.

6.3 Allotment of the students at the First party will be done by the approval of Director of the First party and Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Institution of the Second party.

6.4 The First party would have the right to screen the student's eligibility for admission based on their academic period.

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6.5 The PME Cell of the First party in consultation with the representative of the Second party shall decide the location and sharing quantum of research work.

6.6 The number of student(s) at any particular time will be subjected to the availability of research facilities and scientists' time to guide thesis research at the First party Institution.

6.7 Any student(s) admitted to the First party for training/postgraduate research, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the Pirst party or include in such activities that amount to tantishing the image of the institute, or cause damage to the property, the registration of such student(s) would be summarily terminated. The Second party will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate

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6.8 Fees will be charged from the students by the First party as per Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree programmes us trainees at ICAR institution us vide Letter No. 2-8/2012-)i RD dated 11th Documber, 2012 or revised Guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time. No fee may be charged by the First party from the students registered with AU /DU within NARS. However a student registered with a Second party, outside NARS, will deposit fee of Rs. 10,000/- for training duration of 3 months (not leading to a degree/dissertation) and Rs. 30,000/- per semester (six months) for training, research, dissertation exceeding three months. Any charge in fee structure by KAR will be applicable from the date of revision and shall be charged by the First party.

Article 7, Entry into effect, modification and termination

7.1. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each three/five year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the porty initiating termination. Such sotification must be given to the other party at least six meaths in advance from the effective date of termination.

7.2. All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be

continued until there completion under the terms of this MoU.

7.3 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to:

1. PREAMBLE

- 4.2 The parties may extend or renew this Memorandum by mutual agreement.
- 4.3 Either party may terminate this Memorandum at any time by notifying the other party at least six (6) months in advance of the proposed date of termination.

4.4 Termination or expiry of this Memorandum does not affect any legally binding arrangements in effect or continuing following termination or expiry of this Memorandum.

5. COORDINATION OF AGREED ACTIVITIES

In order to carry out and fulfill the aims of this Memorandum, both parties mutually agree on the following points:

- 1. 1st party agrees to conduct campus interview for the placements of students of 2nd party as and when required. 2nd party agrees to provide boarding and lodging facility to the person (s) coming to conduct campus interview.
- 2. 1st party agrees to conduct visits of students of 2nd party without charging any fees. 2nd party agrees to bear boarding, lodging and transportation charges of the students.
- 3. 1st party agrees to share technical knowledge for developing entrepreneurial skills with the students of 2nd party through guest lecture. 2nd party agrees to bear boarding, lodging and transportation charges of students. 2nd party also agrees to bear transportation and boarding lodging charges for guest lectures to be delivered at University.
- 4. Both parties agree for conducting any other activity in future on which the parties mutually agree.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN TEXAS WOMAN'S UNIVERSITY, USA on behalf of the TWU COLLEGE OF NURSING WITH ETERNAL UNIVERSITY, INDIA

The Texas Woman's University, College of Nursing (TWU) and ETERNAL UNIVERSITY wish to establish a collaborative relationship between the two university Colleges of Nursing to develop academic and cultural interchange:

Area

Subject to mutual written consent, the area of collaboration will include programs or activities offered at either university in which the two institutions believe collaboration is feasible and desirable, and which would contribute to fostering and developing a mutually beneficial relationship between the two universities, elevating the standard and quality of nursing education and program graduates.

Methods

Subject to the subsequent approval of the designated individual of each institution and the availability of funds, assistance shall be carried out through any one or more of the following activities or programs as mutually agreed to by the parties:

- 1. Joint educational projects
- 2. Joint research activities and publications
- 3. Participation in seminars and academic meetings, including symposia, workshops and conferences
- 4. Exchange of academic materials and other education related information
- 5. Special short-term academic programs or projects
- 6. Staff development activities such as capacity building
- 7. Cultural immersion courses
- 8. Nursing education curriculum improvement and benchmarking

The terms of a specific program or activity from the above list and any budgetary needs shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing and signed by both parties prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity. Each university will designate a liaison office or individual to develop and coordinate specific activities and programs.

Effective Date and Length of Agreement

Terms: This agreement will remain in force for a period of five years; to begin on the date designated signatures have been obtained from both universities. This term also includes an option to renew upon the mutual written agreement between the parties hereto.

If one of the universities desires to discontinue this agreement, that university has an obligation to inform the other institution in writing a minimum of three (3) months prior to dissolution of the agreement.

Amendments: No amendment, change or modification to this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) may be made except in a writing signed by all parties hereto.

Governing Law and Venue: This agreement shall be governed and interpreted pursuant to the Constitution laws of the state of Texas. Venue for any suit filed pursuant to this agreement shall be in Denton County, Texas.

This agreement shall become effective after the approved individual of both institutions have signed this document. The signatures of the institutional representatives affixed below signify the interest of both parties in formalizing a collaborative relationship.
