Submission of Abstracts/Extended Abstracts:

- An abstract/extended abstract of not more than 1,000 words, with 4-5 keywords, in MS-Word (in .doc/docx format).
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 points with 1.5 spacing.
- Alignment: Justified
- A short profile, contact address, Email ID, mobile no. and a photograph of the author(s) may be submitted along with the abstract.

Post-Conference authors will be required to submit full papers as per the following guidelines:

- Size of full paper: maximum 6,000 words inclusive of citations, in MS-Word (in .doc/docx format).
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 points with 1.5 spacing.
- The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, size 10 with 1.0 spacing.
- Figures/charts and Tables are to be presented in the manuscript and numbered sequentially. The figures/ charts should also be submitted in a separate MS-Excel file.

- The title page of the manuscript should contain information about the author(s) (including name, E-mail ID, mobile number, postal address, affiliation and professional details).

2. **Last Date for Submission of Full Paper:** 30th June 2025
