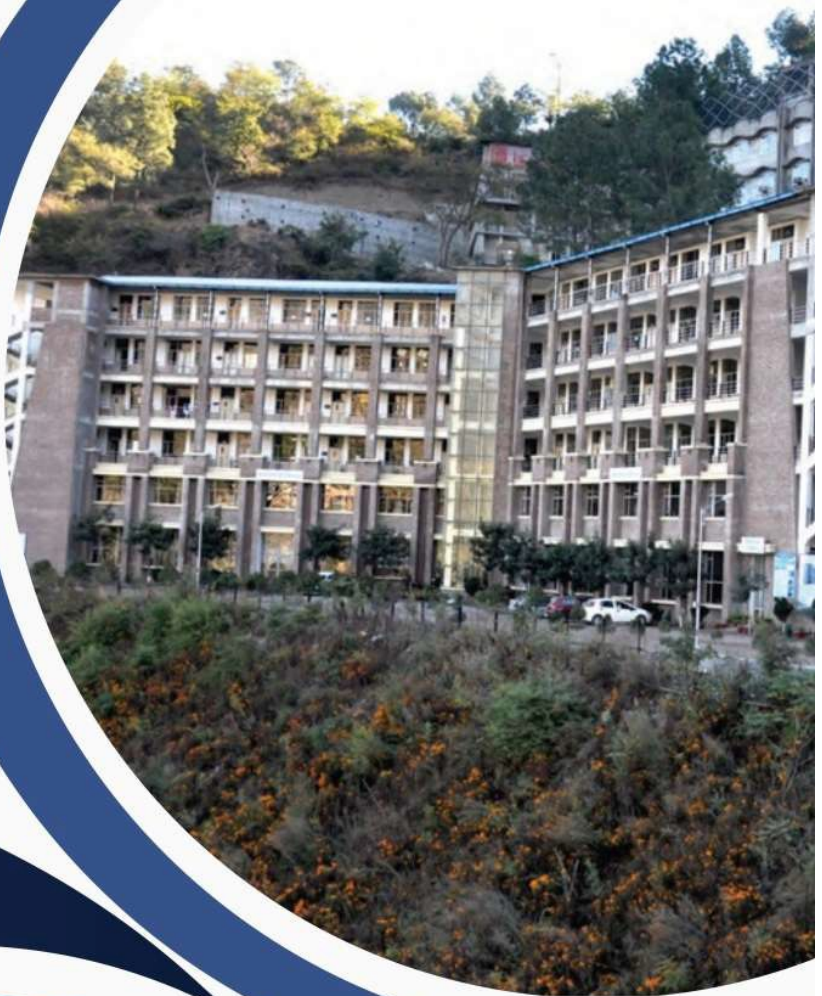

I am a Research Scholar of Horticulture (Vegetable Science) Department of Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture. I delivered my synopsis seminar as per the guidelines of syllabus approved in 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 15/6/2021 vide Item No. 74/13 (iii)/2021 (**Copies Enclosed**). The synopsis was approved as Dean Postgraduate Studies had signed the RDC (Research Degree Committee) (**Copy enclosed**). After four and half months, another Ph.D. student of the same department delivered her synopsis but she did not get approval for the RDC. Thereafter, Dean Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture asked through letter no. EU/DKSGACA/VC/01 dated 17/10/2023 regarding the approval of RDC of second student (Priya Thakur) by giving reference of approval of my synopsis, at that time Dean Postgraduate Studies returned my synopsis by giving a comment "**Attendance**", "**Email**", "**Rio with regarding to ds approval at university level as well as replied on the letter that "Rio was never approved and enquiry was made inadvertently was placed by office clerk in the file"**". He also sent the letter vide Ref No. EU/COE/Ph.D/08 dated 16/10/2023 in which he tried to save his skin and blamed other faculty members and Dean Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture (**Copy enclosed**). In reference to the above said reply Dean Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture, sent a letter subjected "Return of synopsis of Ms Ruksana (BS21PHC001) Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) student by Dean PGS cum CoE office after five months of its submission in their office" on 19/10/2023 (**Copy enclosed**) and "Submission of Synopsis of Ms. Priya Thakur (BS21PHC002) Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) student and Advisory Committee Form for approval" which has a reference to letter vide Ref No. EU/COE/Ph.D/08 dated 16/10/2023 (**Copy enclosed**). I met the Honorable Vice Chancellor regarding this matter and he tried to help me and directed Dean Academics to sort the matter as a result of this a Noting sheet was issued on 7/11/2023 Ref No. EU/DAA/Ph.D/01(j) (**Copy enclosed**). According to which the synopsis was considered to be approved as per 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting. After this Dean PGS returned the result which was submitted in 1/11/2023 by giving comments that "**Is the Synopsis approved?**" and "**Detailed report as per the format to be submitted**" on 23/11/2023. In reply of the comments given by Dean Postgraduate studies, six month report was submitted in his office (**Copy Enclosed**) but till date the result for 4<sup>th</sup> semester is still pending.

I am mentally harassed by Dean Postgraduate Studies for no reason and mistake. Due to this situation, I am suffering with depression and feeling like to quit the degree. If, the situation will not be controlled, Dean Postgraduate studies has to pay all the amount spent on me by my parents till date. As per my opinion, he is the toxic personality because not only me many other students are harassed by him.

Kindly sort out this matter at the earliest. I would be obliged by your act of kindness.

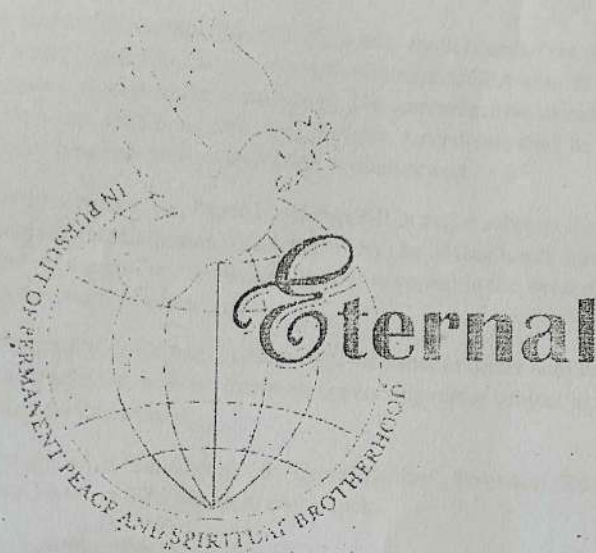

## **Major Guidelines**

### **Synopsis of Thesis**

The synopsis of the thesis must be finalized by the major advisor in consultation with the advisory committee before the commencement of mid-session examination of the 2<sup>nd</sup> registered semester. Prior to this, the student has to deliver the synopsis seminar in the department.

### **Comprehensive Examination**

After having successfully completed 75% of the total credit hours of the prescribed in major (core) and 100% of minor (specialization) courses with minimum OGPA of 6.50/ 10.00, a Ph. D student shall have to pass comprehensive examination. The comprehensive examination shall consist of both written and oral tests, the former preceding the later. A candidate shall be given only two chances to appear in the comprehensive examination, written or oral.

There shall be four written papers. i.e., Paper-I and Paper-II in major subject (Core) and Paper-III and Paper-IV in minor subjects (specialization). Each paper shall be of four hours duration and shall be conducted after a minimum gap of one week. He/ She has to appear in the written comprehensive examination for both the minor subjects.

The syllabus for two papers of major (core) courses and the paper in minor subject shall be decided by the Major Advisor in consultation with the Members concerning minor subject in the Advisory Committee and Head of the Department.

The candidate shall be graded as 'Satisfactory' or 'Unsatisfactory'. To obtain 'Satisfactory' grade, a student must secure not less than 60% Marks in each paper.

### **Oral Comprehensive Examination**

The Oral Comprehensive Examination shall cover both major/ core and minor fields/ specialization and shall be conducted by the Examining Committee comprising the Advisory Committee and one External Examiner who shall be appointed by the Dean PGS. The external examiner shall be a specialist in the students' major field from outside the University.

### **Recommendations of Board of Studies meeting held on 02/06/2021**

It was recommended that Synopsis of Thesis may be submitted in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester in place of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. It was further recommended that the synopsis should be finalized by the student with the help of concerned Major Advisor and all the Advisory Committee Members.

It was recommended that the student may give pre oral comprehensive examination in front of Major Advisor and Advisory Committee Members before the final oral comprehensive examination.

Dr. SK Sharma told that this newly framed course curriculum is having six semesters. Total 75 credit are required as per BSMA committee of ICAR however 77 credit have also been distributed in five parts likewise Major-17, Minor-08, Supporting-05, Seminar-02 and Research-45. These credit hours further allocated semester wise i.e. first semester-17, Second semester-19, Third Semester-11 and fourth to sixth semester-30 i.e. 10 each. Dr. Sharma also told that marks distribution for different credit hour courses has also been attached in the course curriculum having a sheet with the heading as "Scheme of Examination". Dr. Sharma also said that Major Guidelines for synopsis of thesis have also been incorporated in the syllabus.

- c) Dr. Akhilesh Sharma, Professor and Head, Department of Vegetable Science and Floriculture, CSKHPKV, Palampur, District Kangra (HP).

Dr. SK Sharma asked the members to give any valuable comment/suggestion for the incorporation in the syllabus.

As there was no comment/suggestion came forward, house approved the syllabus to be implemented from the Academic Session 2021-22.



- In our University, the Ph.D. Scholar synopsis is presented at the Departmental level and later on at the University level since the inception of this University.
- The Department of Horticulture, DKSGACA want to break this tradition for the reason well known to the HoD of Department and Dean of the College.
- The matter may be discussed at the university level as the Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable) syllabi was approved in the 74<sup>th</sup> ACM (June 15, 2021) in which Dean PGS/ CoE comments were not taken. The handbook 'students guide' was approved in the 75<sup>th</sup> ACM (Aug 8, 2021) and which supersedes the 74<sup>th</sup> ACM.
- This is the only and the first Syllabus Horticulture (Vegetable) approved in the University, which has the guidelines for Departmental seminars, synopsis approval, pre-thesis seminar and other things, which otherwise, it is common for the whole University.

Kindly look into these points of Students Guide 2021.

1. As per students Guide section 2.8.2 **RDC headed by Dean of Post graduate Studies and other members are nominated by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of Dean PGS.**
2. **The RDC will guide monitor and evaluate the research progress.**
3. As per item 2.8.8 Evaluation of Ph.D. Thesis: **The research work completed to the satisfaction of supervisor(s), the RDC and procedural satisfaction of Dean Postgraduate studies, the student will make pre-Ph.D. presentation in the department open to all faculty members and students for getting feedback and comments which may be incorporated in the thesis under the guidance of supervisor.**
4. As per section 3.9 c. **Controller of examination shall centrally organize written examination in consultation with Dean PGS/Dean of the College.**
5. As per Section 3.9 j. **With the approval of the Vice Chancellor, the Dean PGS shall appoint External Examiner for the conduct of oral comprehensive examination, along with Dean PGS, Dean of the college, Head of the Department, \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_by the Dean PGS.**

The Department of Horticulture with specialization (Vegetable) has only two faculty members and how it is justified to have departmental seminar approval.


Kindly answer the following queries of the office of Dean PGS.

1. Why the Department of Horticulture (Vegetable) with only two faculty members does not want to conduct the seminar at University level and break the tradition (Are they not competent enough?)

- Oral viva voce and synopsis approval is conducted by the external examiner to improve the quality of thesis work. Why not approval from the external expert kindly explains?
3. The comprehensive examination conducted by the department from the course taught. Is it appropriate (only two faculty members)? Explain the quality of such Ph.D. student by doing so.
  4. Kindly inform if any Masters/Doctorate syllabus approved by the ACM which has the Major guidelines for synopsis, approval etc. If not why it has been done deliberately in this syllabus?
  5. As per syllabi, passed in the 74<sup>th</sup> ACM the Dean PGS appears to be mere spectator and big clerk for the agriculture Ph.D. students.

#### Fact from other Universities and ours

6. The Dean PGS job at Palampur University is "The Dean, Postgraduate Studies supervises the postgraduate teaching and research programmes of all the four constituent colleges (Agriculture, Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Basic Sciences and Community Science) in collaboration with the Directorate of Research. The University has master (M.Sc.) programme in 27 and doctoral (Ph.D.) in 14 subjects in different constituent colleges".
7. The pioneer Institution PAU, Ludhiana the Dean PGS as per RIB 3.7 has the powers as per the "**Postgraduate Committee** The postgraduate Committee consists of all the Deans and Directors, Registrar (or his nominee), and one senior Professor from each constituent college by rotation. **The Dean of Postgraduate Studies is the Chairman of the Postgraduate Committee.** The Postgraduate Committee has the general jurisdiction over all matters relating to Postgraduate education. The courses and curricula recommended for postgraduate students by the Board of Studies of the various constituent colleges are examined by the Postgraduate Committee before these are submitted to the Academic Council. The Committee meets at least once every semester".
8. As per our Act and statues (EU) the Dean PGS has the powers to organize and co-ordinate of postgraduate research across faculty/school/ colleges and department of the University.
9. I request the Dean DKSGACA that such letter waste time of my office and which can be sorted out easily by discourse.

Similarly the Ph.D. Synopsis Seminar of Ms. Priya Thakur (BS21PHC002) Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) student was held on 29/09/2023. Your good self was Honourably invited to attend the seminar by the Circular duly issued by Head of the Department.

Despite the request through circular, although your good self was also invited on the day of the synopsis seminar by the Major Advisor / Head of the Department and the concerned students **but being present in the campus your good self has not attended the synopsis seminar and directed the HoD and the student concerned that the Dean of the college may conduct the synopsis seminar at his own level and accordingly the synopsis seminar was conducted with due intimation to your good office.**

**Reply:** The matter regarding the finalization of syllabus of Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) was discussed in the Board of Studies meeting of the college held on 02/06/2021 in which Dr. S.K. Chauhan, Additional Registrar, Dr. Ajar Nath Yadav Assistant Controller of Examination and nominee of Dean PGS cum CoE and Dr. Surjan Singh Associate Professor and nominee of the Dean Academic Affairs were present.

Dr. V. Pandey, ADG Horticulture, ICAR, New Delhi and Dr. S.K. Sharma, Joint Director Research, Dr. YS Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry, Nauni, Solan, External Expert Members in the Board of Studies of this college also participated in the meeting and gave their valuable suggestions. After discussion, the Board of Studies recommended the **syllabus and synopsis guidelines** to be followed for Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) and the same were sent to Registrar, Eternal University, Baru Sahib through email dated 03/06/2021 for its placement in the Academic Council Meeting for discussion and approval. **It may be mentioned here the entire document was also sent to you good self through email dated 03/06/2021 for your perusal and guidance.** This matter was discussed in the 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 15/06/2021 vide item no. 74/13(iii)/2021 pertaining to Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) syllabus and it was approved. In this meeting your good self was also present.

**Hence to say that the comment of Dean PGS were not obtained is away from the facts.** The course approval along with the synopsis guidelines was approved in the 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 15/06/2021 in which your good self was present and its proceedings were sent to your good office for compliance. **In the 75<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 19/08/2021, no comments were received from your good self regarding the item approved 74/13(iii)/2021 pertaining to Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) syllabus and synopsis guidelines, the proceedings were ratified by the Honourable Vice Chancellor.**

The handbook "students guide" was approved in the 75<sup>th</sup> ACM (Aug 8, 2021) and which supersedes the 74<sup>th</sup> ACM as mentioned by your good self is misleading of the facts as it has no link for the item approved 74/13(iii)/2021 pertaining to Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) syllabus and ratified in the 75<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 19/08/2021.

**Comment No. 4:** This is the only and the first Syllabus Horticulture (Vegetable Science) approved in the University, which has the guidelines for Departmental seminars, synopsis approval, pre-thesis seminar and other things, which otherwise, it is common for the whole University.

**Reply:** The Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) is being run as per ICAR guidelines where a student has to study Major, Minor, Supporting courses and two credit seminars spreading over two semesters. The total minimum requirements to complete this degree programme is 75 credits. **This is certainly a different Ph.D. degree programme as compared to other Ph.D. degree programmes being run in the university.**

**Comment No. 5:** As per students guide section 2.8.2 RDC headed by Dean of Post Graduate Studies and other members are nominated by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of Dean PGS.

If your good self thinks that the present two members working in the Department of Horticulture are not competent, then I request your good self to send the proposal to the competent authority of the university for their replacement and appointment of competent faculty members as per your choice.

**Comment No. 13: Kindly inform if any Masters/Doctorate syllabus approved by the ACM which has the Major guidelines for synopsis, approval etc. If not why it has been done deliberately in this syllabus?**

**Reply:** The Department of Horticulture is following the guidelines for running Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) degree programme as per guidelines approved in the 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 15/06/2021 vide item no. 74/13(iii)/2021 pertaining to Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) syllabus. **There is nothing deliberate in running this syllabus as you have mentioned in your comments.**

**Comment No. 15: The Dean PGS job at Palampur University is "The Dean, Postgraduate Studies supervises the postgraduate teaching and research programmes of all the four constituent colleges (Agriculture, Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Basic Sciences and Community Science) in collaboration with the Directorate of Research. The university has master (M.Sc.) programme in 27 and doctoral (Ph.D.) in 14 subjects in different constituent colleges"**

**Reply:** At premier institute i.e. ICAR-IARI, the PG student's research synopsis is being finalized at the division level and then the same is approved by Joint Director Research.

In Dr. YS Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry, Nauni, Solan, there is no post of Dean PGS and all the PG students' research programmes are being monitored by Director of Research. All the PG students' synopsis seminars are held at their department level and they are being sent to the Director Research for approval.

In all the 13 constituent colleges of Central Agricultural University, Imphal, five Agriculture Universities in Rajasthan, CSKHPKV Palampur, CCS, HAU Hisar, Acharya Narendra Deva University of Agriculture and Technology, Kumarganj, Ayodhya and GB Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar, the Ph.D. students synopsis is being finalized at departmental level in which either Dean PGS or his nominee is invited for discussion and finalization of the programme. The same procedure has been followed for finalization of Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science) students' synopsis as per existing rules approved by the Academic Council. Your good self was invited to attend the synopsis seminar for which the circular was issued by Major Advisor/HoD but although being present in the campus your good self has not attended the synopsis seminar. After deliberation of the synopsis seminar which was chaired by the Dean of the college, the concerned students have submitted the synopsis for your kind approval.

**Comment No. 16: The pioneer Institution PAU, Ludhiana the Dean PGS as per RIB 3.7 has the powers as per the "Postgraduate Committee the Postgraduate Committee consists of all the Deans and Directors, Registrar (or his nominee), and one senior Professor from each constituent college by rotation. The Dean of Postgraduate Studies is the Chairman of the**

## **Major Guidelines**

### **Synopsis of Thesis**

The synopsis of the thesis must be finalized by the major advisor in consultation with the advisory committee before the commencement of mid-session examination of the 2<sup>nd</sup> registered semester. Prior to this, the student has to deliver the synopsis seminar in the department.

### **Comprehensive Examination**

After having successfully completed 75% of the total credit hours of the prescribed in major (core) and 100% of minor (specialization) courses with minimum OGPA of 6.50/ 10.00, a Ph. D student shall have to pass comprehensive examination. The comprehensive examination shall consist of both written and oral tests, the former preceding the later. A candidate shall be given only two chances to appear in the comprehensive examination, written or oral.

There shall be four written papers. i.e., Paper-I and Paper-II in major subject (Core) and Paper-III and Paper-IV in minor subjects (specialization). Each paper shall be of four hours duration and shall be conducted after a minimum gap of one week. He/ She has to appear in the written comprehensive examination for both the minor subjects.

The syllabus for two papers of major (core) courses and the paper in minor subject shall be decided by the Major Advisor in consultation with the Members concerning minor subject in the Advisory Committee and Head of the Department.

The candidate shall be graded as 'Satisfactory' or 'Unsatisfactory'. To obtain 'Satisfactory' grade, a student must secure not less than 60% Marks in each paper.

### **Oral Comprehensive Examination**

The Oral Comprehensive Examination shall cover both major/ core and minor fields/ specialization and shall be conducted by the Examining Committee comprising the Advisory Committee and one External Examiner who shall be appointed by the Dean PGS. The external examiner shall be a specialist in the students' major field from outside the University.

### **Recommendations of Board of Studies meeting held on 02/06/2021**

It was recommended that Synopsis of Thesis may be submitted in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester in place of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. It was further recommended that the synopsis should be finalized by the student with the help of concerned Major Advisor and all the Advisory Committee Members.

It was recommended that the student may give pre oral comprehensive examination in front of Major Advisor and Advisory Committee Members before the final oral comprehensive examination.

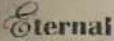



Kindly look into these points of Students Guide 2021.

1. As per students Guide section 2.8.2 **RDC headed by Dean of Post graduate Studies and other members are nominated by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of Dean PGS.**
2. **The RDC will guide monitor and evaluate the research progress.**
3. As per item 2.8.8 Evaluation of Ph.D. Thesis: **The research work completed to the satisfaction of supervisor(s), the RDC and procedural satisfaction of Dean Postgraduate studies, the student will make pre-Ph.D. presentation in the department open to all faculty members and students for getting feedback and comments which may be incorporated in the thesis under the guidance of supervisor.**
4. As per section 3.9 c. **Controller of examination shall centrally organize written examination in consultation with Dean PGS/Dean of the College.**
5. As per Section 3.9 j. **With the approval of the Vice Chancellor, the Dean PGS shall appoint External Examiner for the conduct of oral comprehensive examination, along with Dean PGS, Dean of the college, Head of the Department, \_\_\_\_\_ by the Dean PGS.**

The Department of Horticulture with specialization (Vegetable) has only two faculty members and how it is justified to have departmental seminar approval.


Kindly answer the following queries of the office of Dean PGS.

The University has master (M.Sc.) programme in 27 and doctoral (Ph.D.) in 14 subjects in different constituent colleges".
7. The pioneer Institution PAU, Ludhiana the Dean PGS as per RIB 3.7 has the powers as per the "Postgraduate Committee The postgraduate Committee consists of all the Deans and Directors, Registrar (or his nominee), and one senior Professor from each constituent college by rotation. **The Dean of Postgraduate Studies is the Chairman of the Postgraduate Committee.** The Postgraduate Committee has the general jurisdiction over all matters relating to Postgraduate education. The courses and curricula recommended for postgraduate students by the Board of Studies of the various constituent colleges are examined by the Postgraduate Committee before these are submitted to the Academic Council. The Committee meets at least once every semester".
