Departmental Activity

Organic Farming



The major industry responsible for fulfilling the nutritional requirement of every person is the agricultural industry. But the major challenge in the agricultural industry is the crop losses due to attack of insect pests. We are working over the biocontrol attribute of entomopathogenic nematodes (EPNs) against various lepidopteran insect pests since 2019 at Eternal University Baru Sahib, Tehsil Pachhad, District Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh. EPNs were isolated from the soil of fruit orchards from various districts of Himachal Pradesh. Bio-formulations were prepared in the form of sponge stock as a liquid formulation. Various bioassay studies were performed in the laboratory to instigate the insecticidal potential of these isolated EPNs.

After getting the successful results under the laboratory bioassay studies, these EPNs were then applied against the lepidopteran insect pests under protected cultivation. Application of these EPNs has been found as an excellent approach in the field of sustainability. The EPNs are highly virulent, easy for application, safe for non-target animals and are the best alternative in comparison to harmful chemical insecticides. Under the protected cultivation sponge stock formulation of EPNs were applied against the insect pests of cabbage and broccoli. These EPNs were proved as a brilliant source of biocontrol agents than harmful chemical insecticides, in managing the insect pest's population. The produce thus recovered was organic and is free from chemical residue. Even studies were going on in the Department to evaluate the insecticidal potential of these biocontrol agents in the open field also. The application of nematode based formulations will become a boon to the local farmers of this region, for the management of wide range of insect pests.

Departmental visit to the Akal Waste Management Unit at Baru Sahib Campus



Keeping in view the importance of clean environment, department of Chemistry & Biochemistry organised a visit of UG and PG chemistry students to the Akal Waste Management Unit at Baru Sahib campus where Mr. Santosh Shukla interacted with the students and discussed the various methods through which the organic, inorganic and biomedical waste produced in the campus is managed and treated in the Unit. Further, the students were educated about the different techniques that are used to made useful materials from the waste. One such example is the light-weight brick made up of plastic which has been patented and is also used in the construction of roads in the campus. In addition to this, students were made aware of the day-to-day minor yet crucial issues that pose complications in the efficient working of the Unit and simple but efficient ways through which such issues could be resolved or minimized were also suggested by the Waste Management team so that everybody could contribute in moving a step forward towards the clean environment. At last, there was a discussion round where students asked questions and also shared their views.

Student Outreach Programme [Distinguished Lecture on 'Spin Based Logic and Memory Devices' by Dr. Rohit Medwal, from Nanyang Technological University Singapore]



On September 18, 2021; Department of Physics, Eternal University Baru Sahib started a "Distinguished Lecture Series" through virtual mode. The main motive of this lecture series is to trigger off the post graduate students for advanced research. A lecture was delivered by the distinguished speaker Dr. Rohit Medwal, from Nanyang Technological University Singapore on "Spin Based Logic and Memory Devices". Most of the faculty members including Dean Akal College of Basic Sciences, Dr. Sandipan Gupta; faculty members of Department of physics, Dr. Poonam Kumari, Dr. Madan Lal, students from Eternal University and other institutions were present during the event.

Dr. Medwal explained the fundamental concepts behind the "Spintronics"- a new emerging branch of Physics that how one can use electron spin-based electronics in day-to-day life. To add, Dr. Negi didn't forget to raise the important aspect of solar energy harvesting, if it can be connected to spintronics.

He mentioned that the department of Physics, Eternal University Baru Sahib has been actively working on the different schemes to further improve the efficiency of the solar devices. His concern of integrating the current electronic devices with the concept of spintronics would enable new horizon in the field of research.





5-days training program was organised at the premises of Eternal University under the NABARD sponsored project entitled "Integrated Farming System with Allied Sectors for Socio-economic upliftment of Rural Farmer Families of Himachal Pradesh". In this program demonstration was given to the farmers on Integrated Farming Model (IFS) at University farm. IFS represent an appropriate combination of farm enterprises. The waste material of one enterprise is used as input for the productive functioning of other enterprise. This is an effective strategy in raising incomes, generating employment and alleviating poverty among small and marginal farmers. The training was given on enterprises as dairy farming, vermin-composting, silage making, horticultural/agricultural farming, food processing and water harvesting. It will impart awareness and new learnings to the local farmers of this area. These trainings were for 05 days with 40 participants and also including one-day exposure visit to Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Kandaghat.



An educational tour for the UG & PG students of Akal College of Economics, Commerce and Management, Eternal University, Baru Sahib was organized to Punjab state from 23 rd – 26 th February, 2023. In this tour, 25 students were taken to various places by a team comprising Dr. Manjinder Kaur, Coordinator, Mr. Amber Srivastava Co-coordinator and Ms. Kuldeep Kaur, member. On the first day the students could pay obeisance at Gurudwara Patalpuri Sahib at Kiratpur, named by Sri Guru Har Gobind Sahib Ji. Here the sixth guru, Sri Guru Har Gobind Sahib and the seventh guru Sri Guru Har Rai ji were cremated and Sri Guru Har Krishan Sahib's hearth was brought here after the cremation at Delhi.

Next day they visited Vira sat-e-Khalsa which is a very famous museum of Sikhism, located in the holy town, Anandpur Sahib. Our students got knowledge about 500 years of the Sikh history and the 300 th anniversary of the birth of Khalsa, based on the scriptures written by the tenth and last human guru, Shri Guru Gobind Singh. After that students could pay obeisance at Akal Takhat Sri Keshgarh Sahib and had the langar. Here, they came to know the origin of Khalsa in 1699 where on 13 th April in the same year on the Baisakhi day, tenth Master Guru Gobind Singh Ji created Khalsa by baptizing five beloved Sikhs known as "Panj Piaras".

In the evening of day two they were taken to Amritsar and gave obeisance at Darbar Sahib, Golden Temple. Here the students came to know about the history of the Harmandir Sahib, the fourth Guru of Sikhs, Guru Ram Das, who had initially constructed a pool here and now houses the Golden Temple or Harmandir Sahib. The students came to know that the pond surrounding the Golden Temple is considered extremely sacred by the devotees and they believe that taking a bath in the holy water of the Sarovar will purify them from their karma. Besides, they learned the importance of Akal Takhat which was founded by sixth Sikh master Guru Har Gobind Sahib ji in the year 1609.

On the third day (24 th February, 2023), the students visited Jallianwala Bagh, a historic garden and memorial of national importance located close to the Golden Temple complex. This Bagh has preserved the memory of those wounded and killed in the Massacre that took place on the festival of Baisakhi on 13 th April 1919. After that, they visited the markets and left for Wag Aha border around 2:00 pm to witness the Beating Retreat ceremony which is a daily CAPF BSF practice that the security forces of India and Pakistan have jointly followed since 1959. The drill is characterized by elaborate and rapid dance-like maneuvers and raising legs as high as possible, which have been described as "colourful". Students enjoyed the most at Wagah border.

On the fourth day (25 th February, 2023) they reached at Akal University, Talwandi Sabo, to have an interaction and see the infrastructure facilities available at the University. At Akal University, they got very warm welcome by Madam Raman who took a round of campus including girls' hostel, class rooms, labs, seminar hall and other places. Students were introduced to the staff of the University also. After having interaction with faculty, they took lunch in university mess and left for Shri Damdama Sahib, which is one of the five takhts or Seat of Temporal Authority of Sikhism, located in Talwandi Sabo in Punjab.

At this place, the tenth Sikh master Guru Gobind Singh, prepared the full version of the Sikh scriptures called Sri Guru Granth Sahib in 1705. After this, they left for Patiala and on the way, they visited Mastuana Sahib, gurudwara constructed by the Saint Baba Attar Singh ji who believed that without basic education, progress of one's own self as well as country is impossible. In the evening they reached Patiala and stayed in a Kalghidhar Gurudwara Sahib with the assistance of S. Boota Singh, president of Gurudwara. The committee members of gurudwara Sahib served langar for the students who were impressed by their hospitality.

On the last day that is on 26 th February, the students visited Shri Dukh Nivaran Gurudwara, Patiala where visitors have faith in the healing qualities of the water. 
