




# 1 HP GIRLS BN NCC, SOLAN ETERNAL UNIVERSITY, BARU SAHIB,

**SIRMAUR** 





The NCC in India was formed in 1948. It can be traced back to the 'University Corps', which was created under the Indian Defence Act 1917, with the objective to make up for a shortage of personnel in the Army. In 1949, the Girls Division was formed in order to provide equal opportunities to school and college-going girls.

The NCC is optional for the students of the undergraduate programs. Every enrolled student in NCC undergoes two years training during Bachelor's Degree program. The 1 HP Girls Battalion NCC Solan conducted Annual Training Camp from 10-17 December, 2022 (senior wing) and 06 January -13 January at Eternal University, Baru Sahib. About 500 Cadets (Girls) of various colleges of Himachal Pradesh attended that camp and other ATC was held on 21st to 30th December, 2023 at Himalayan Group of Institution, Kala Amb. A total of 90 cadets received the camp certificate during the annual training camp. In 2023 the 16 Cadets achieved BEE Certificate and 24 cadets CEE Certificate which was conducted by 1 HP Girls Bn NCC Solan. The aim of camp was to impart multidisciplinary training including Drills, Weapon training, Map reading, Field craft, Battle craft, Physical fitness, Sports activities, Yoga, Social service and Community Development to the cadets for talent and holistic development. The cadets also benefitted from better understanding of time management, self- discipline and selfless service to the nation and leadership traits.


