ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY



The University came into existence with the visionary grace of most revered Padma Shri awardee Sant Baba Iqbal Singh Ji, former Director Agriculture, Himachal Pradesh, President Kalgidhar Trust, former Hon'ble Chancellor, Eternal University, Baru Sahib and above all the social reformer of rural women in general and hill women in particular. According to his belief "modern scientific education alone may not serve the humanity well, unless it is amalgamated with spiritual education". Throughout his journey, he could effectively translate the visions of Sant Baba Attar Singh Ji (Mastuana wale) and Sant Baba Teja Singh Ji by establishing the first Akal Academy in 1986 at Baru Sahib. Later, it spread to a network of 130 CBSE affiliated Akal Academies over six states and two Universities to impart value-based education from nursery to Doctorate level. As part of the vision, prophesy and prayers of the visionary Saints, Eternal University was established under the Himachal Pradesh State Act No. 3 of 2009 which has been recognized by UGC, AICTE, INC, NCTE, DSIR, DBT, DST & DRDO and accredited by NAAC. The B. Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture (Four year degree programme) has also been accredited by ICAR, New Delhi for five years from 2022 to 2027. The graduates of this unique education system are not only outstanding in academics, but also carry high moral values. They have love for humanity, compassion for the weak and the poor and sense of selfless service for the community.

Akal College of Nursing is the first nursing college established in the year 2008 by the 'Kalgidhar Trust', in the valley of divine peace 'Baru Sahib' situated in the shadows of the great Himalayas in the Northern part of India the well-known land of Gods and Goddess, thus called "Dev-Bhoomi"

Himachal Pradesh. Akal College of Nursing was also accredited by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi vide Resolution No. 138/02/August/2008 of dated 14th October 2008 & approved by H.P. Registration Council. The Akal College of Nursing offers B.Sc. Nursing, M.Sc. Nursing and Ph.D. Nursing courses approved/ affiliated by Himachal Pradesh Nursing Registration Council (HPNRC) and Indian Nursing Council (INC). Similarly, Eternal University is the first private university of Himachal Pradesh to start College of Agriculture in 2014 to admit 60 girl students. The lush green and pollution free camp in Himachal Pradesh is fully residential for faculty and students with all the basic facilities for comfortable living, excellent academic career pursuit and participation in cocurricular and spiritual activities for their holistic development. It has now been transformed and recognized as a modern Gurukul exclusively for girls' education. The Eternal University has been regularly organizing conferences, symposia, workshops, Kisan Melas, Annual Sports meets and celebrating national and international days, conducting Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) and creating opportunities for student's awareness with the latest developments in the areas of their interest and confidence to share their knowledge with other faculty, students and stake holders. For the people of district Sirmour being one of the most backward districts of Himachal Pradesh, the establishment of Eternal University, Baru Sahib has proved to be a boon with many hopes as well as expectations for addressing their problems related to education, health, nutrition, agricultural production, skill development, employment and women empowerment. for their inclusive development. After its establishment in the year 2009, with a mission and mandate of value-based education and women empowerment, the university has demonstrated its commitment to society through great impact in teaching, research and transfer of technology. It is continuously looking forward to set new dimensions in the research area of modern agriculture, food technology, biotechnology, public health, basic sciences, social sciences and renewable energy with teams of world class scientists and external funding support from different funding agencies of Government of India and Himachal Pradesh.

DR. KHEM SINGH GILL AKAL COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE

Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture (erstwhile Akal College of Agriculture) was established on 01/07/2014 as a constituent college of Eternal University, Baru Sahib with the basic objective of providing quality education at undergraduate and post graduate levels for girl students in the field of Agricultural Sciences. At present college is offering 02 undergraduate degree programmes i.e. B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture and B. Tech. Food Technology as per Sixth Deans' Committee Reports, 10 post graduate programmes i.e. M.Sc. Ag. Agronomy, M.Sc. Horticulture (Vegetable Science), M.Sc. Horticulture (Fruit Science), M.Sc. Horticulture (Floriculture and Landscape Architecture), M.Sc. Ag. Plant Pathology, M.Sc. Ag. Genetics and Plant Breeding, M.Sc. Ag. Entomology, M.Sc. Biotechnology, M. Tech. Food Technology and M.Sc. Food Science and Technology and 06 Ph.D. degree programmes i.e. Ph.D. Horticulture (Vegetable Science), Ph.D. Agronomy, Ph.D. Entomology, Ph.D. Biotechnology, Ph.D. Food Technology and Ph.D. Genetics and Plant Breeding.

The college has four Research Stations located at Kakhli, Machher, Chhapang and Machlog to cater the needs of M.Sc. / Ph.D. students' research trials and external funding agencies research projects. At Research Station Kakhli, crop cafeteria w.r.t. vegetable science, fruit science and floriculture have been established. Fields to students to carry out Rural Agricultural Work experience have been allotted. The M.Sc. students of Department of Agronomy, Plant Breeding and Genetics, Floriculture and Landscape Architecture and Fruit Science are conducting their field trials at this station. Department of Food Technology has been allotted the area to produce fodder for the cattle. A fruit orchard having about 437 plants has been established. Vermicompost unit has been established at this station to give the practical training to the students and farmers. The college has also established a dairy comprising 06 cows at this station.

The research activities pertaining to M.Sc. / Ph.D. students of Department of Genetics Plant Breeding and Biotechnology are being carried out at Research Station Machher. A Bee Keeping Unit having good numbers of beehives boxes has also been established at this station to meet the needs of practical training of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture students and farmers training programme. A mushroom production unit where at present Oyster Mushroom is being cultivated has been established at this station as a training center for B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture students.

At Research Station Chhapang, research work is concentrated on protective cultivation of vegetable crops. M.Sc. Horticulture students of Department of Horticulture are conducting their trials at this station pertaining to Vegetable Science and Fruit Science. There are 04 poly houses at this station having a dimension of 25-meter length, 20-meter width and 15-meter height each. At Research Station Machlog, germplasm of fruit crops pertaining to temperate and sub-tropical crops is being maintained. Production work of vegetable crops has also been started at this station. The college has developed elite plant breeding material pertaining to bio fortified wheat with high iron and zinc content in grain, improved bread making quality and maize lines with high quality protein having high lysine and tryptophan amino acids, functional foods such as fox tail millet, finger millet, buck wheat, amaranths, soybean, oats and barley. Production technology of tomato, capsicum and strawberry under protected conditions has been standardized.

The National Agricultural Education Accreditation Boards (NAEAB) in its 31st meeting held on 19/07/2022 has granted accreditation to B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture degree programme for a period of five years from 19/07/2022 to 18/07/2027 which was conveyed to this university vide letter no. Edn.1/35/2018-EQR dated 05/08/2022.

AKAL COLLEGE OF ARTS & SOCIAL SCIENCES

The Akal College of Arts and Social Sciences has five departments:

Department of Music – This wing was established in the year 2008, under the aegis of UGC approved Eternal University, at Baru Sahib (H.P). The objective for setting up this institute was a holistic approach of imparting knowledge in the field of Music (both Vocal & Instrumental), following Guru- Shishya – Paramapra, the system in which Indian traditional music was nurtured & thrived for centuries. The institute thus follows integrated approach, by working towards not only academic learning along- with professional skills development in Music but also towards harnessing good value system. The USP of Department of Music is that, it provides students an opportunity with a rare combination of learning Divine Music, along with ancient Indian string instruments like Rabab, Taaus, Dilruba, Taar- Shehnai, Sarod, Sitar, Sarangi, Saranda and Violin, that makes the students well groomed, more confident of one's abilities & is of immense help to them while seeking employment for teaching in the field of Music. Students from this Department regularly perform live with variety of string instruments for Shabad-Kirtan presentation, at various National &International locations. Most of the students who have passed out from this department till date have been successfully placed at various institutions across the country.

Department of English: The Department of English since its inception has been playing a pivotal role in establishing itself as a tour de force in terms of learning and leading minds. The department has been equipped with sound sources and resources. It has skilled professors who are qualified in their respective domains to enhance the credentials of the department as well as the students. The department is not only contributing its services to Akal College of Arts & Social Sciences, but as an offshoot department it is also rendering its services to other Colleges /Departments of the university like Agriculture, Commerce, Management, Basic Sciences and Engineering. The department strives to carry forth intriguing research and have Doctoral students working in myriad areas. Separate academic activities are held in the department from time to time. Currently the Department runs Graduate, Post Graduate and Doctoral Programs. It also has a Communication Lab where it provides the students with a hands-on experience in linguistics and phonetics.

Department of Psychology: Since its conception under the Akal College of Arts & Social Sciences at the EU campus, the faculty of the department has contributed immensely to the field of psychology. The department of psychology has a multidimensional image in terms of excellent research and teaching and has been a leader in the region. The balance between pure and applied research has given the department a rare profile. Major areas of research are educational psychology, clinical psychology, neuro psychology, organizational psychology, abnormal psychology, cognitive psychology, counselling & Guidance Psychology, sports psychology, positive psychology and health psychology.

The department runs its three programmes, B.Sc. (Hons.) Psychology, M.A. Psychology and Doctorate of Psychology (PhD) drawing strongly from intellectual sources. The focus is to bring learning through bridging theory and practice for the erudition so as to create new kinds of knowledge. At the master's level a wide spectrum of courses spread over a period of four semesters are offered in order to equip the students to pursue specialization in areas of their interest. Course curriculum has both academic as well as societal relevance and incorporates contemporary debates. Some of the courses are compulsory courses aimed at providing strong theoretical and methodological base while others are optional courses.

Department of Punjabi: The Department of Punjabi plays a vital role in the Akal College of Arts and Social Sciences (ACASS). The primary aim of this department is to provide advanced knowledge of Punjabi, the mother tongue of the majority of students, and to inculcate a cultural and creative awareness amongst these students. The department focuses, moreover, on creating a strong emotional intelligence through the mediums of language and literature, so that students can better integrate as part of an ideal society. The department provides lectures and seminars to different streams, including Humanities, Music, Psychology and Science students at the undergraduate level. The Department has also post graduate studies in Punjabi subject with M.A.(Hons.) and the department has also started Ph.D. in Punjabi. The faculty members of this department are all UGC accredited and have passed their NET exams and are experienced in teaching and research in their specific fields of interest (e.g. literature, linguistics, folk culture and folklore, etc.). The department also organizes various activities and exercises to boost the students' confidence and increase their knowledge and cultural awareness. These activities include poetry writing and recitation, declamation, and quiz contests.

Library and Information Science: Eternal University has also two departmental libraries i.e. one each in Akal College of Nursing and Akal College of Education which are well connected with the Central Library. The library has more than 42000 books of nation and International authors on the open shelves and also subscribe 35 national/international journal/magazines. More than 300 CDs/DVDs of different subjects are available in the Library. The library has also seating capacity for 260 readers studying in a very calm and quite environment. The library remain open from 08.00 AM to 08.00 PM on all working day and 08.00 AM to 5.30 PM on all holidays.



Akal College of Health and Allied Sciences holds the distinction of running first Nursing College in the state of Himachal Pradesh. It was established in 2008 by the 'Kalgidhar Trust' in the serene surroundings of 'Baru Sahib,' a place known for its divine tranquillity, situated in the northern part of Himachal Pradesh, near the Himalayas. Akal College of Nursing introduced the M.Sc. Nursing course in 2014. These courses are approved and affiliated by the Himachal Pradesh Nursing Registration Council (HPNRC) and the Indian Nursing Council (INC). The college admits 60+5 Bachelors of Nursing students annually, with an additional 5 students through the PM-SSS Scheme. For the Masters in Nursing program, the college admits 25 nursing students each year. The Master's program offers specialization options, including Medical Surgical Nursing, Obstetric & Gynaecological Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, and Community Health Nursing.



UNIVERSITY INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

The Eternal University campus is 100% residential and provides all basic facilities, amenities and is having excellent infrastructure.

ACADEMIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Six storied building with three blocks is housing five of the seven constituent colleges. The lift is accessible for the students to reach different floors of their respective colleges. Two colleges viz, Akal College of Health & Allied Sciences and Akal College of Education are situated in separate buildings. The Department of Music of the Akal College of Arts and Social Sciences operates from the spacious halls and lecture rooms around the main Gurudwara in the center of the campus. A new state-of-the-art building of Dr. Khem Singh Gill Akal College of Agriculture with seven floors is under construction. Another sophisticated instrument laboratory of Food & Technology has been set up as a separate building of two floors wih a training hall facility.

HOSTELS

There are two main girls' hostels. One is specifically for Nursing college students and the other for the rest of the university's girl students. The Nursing girls' hostel is having 66 rooms with triple beds capacity and 24 rooms with double bed capacity in a six storied building with lift facility. Each floor has common washrooms. In addition to this, there is a visitor room, reading room, recreational room, stores, and an interfaith hall. There is a canteen providing not only tea and drinks but also delicious food of choice to the students.

The Eternal University main girls' hostel has 9 floors having 27 rooms on each floor with four-bed capacity, 215 rooms with triple bed capacity, 7 rooms with single-bed capacity, which have sharing washrooms at two corners of the hostel on each floor and 18 rooms with attached washroom for Ph.D. scholars. All the rooms are well-ventilated and fully furnished including beds, study desks, chairs, almirahs, etc. There are store and common rooms on each floor. Common rooms are used for reading, indoor games, meditation, canteen, yoga, gym, etc.

The mess of the hostels is being run by Kalgidhar Trust to provide fresh, clean, and nutritious food according to a pre-decided menu involving the students' representatives. The dining hall of the mess in the hostels is equipped with water coolers connected with the supply of a common purification unit. The hostel has the provision of geysers and a connection of boiler in all the shared washrooms to provide hot water. Coolers are in place one each floor with the supply of drinking water.

There is a laundry facility available near Darbar Hall. All the efforts are being made to give a homely environment to the students.

Akal Charitable Hospital - A Unit of Kalgidhar Society

The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib is a non-profit charitable organization focused on providing education and health care for more than three decades. Akal Charitable hospital is one of the initiatives by the Kalgidhar Society conceptualized by Honourable Baba Iqbal Singh Ji for the benefit of ailing humanity. The hospital provides round-the-clock care to the students and staff members on campus as well as to the residents of this hilly area. The unique infrastructural facilities in the Akal Charitable hospital complex is the multi-specialty with a capacity of one hundred beds where healthcare facilities are provided to underprivileged rural and hilly people at very nominal charges. Free medical and surgical camps and health check-up camps are also organized. Ambulance services are available to tackle any kind of emergency. The hospital has a dedicated team of expert doctors, trained nurses, and paramedical staff to ensure the health safety of the local patients and in-house population of 3500 (staff and students of Eternal University as well as Akal Academy).

INSTRUCTIONS/REGULATIONS REGARDING RAGGING

As per the Supreme Court judgment in Vishwa Jagriti Mission vs Central Government and Others (2001) 6 SCC 577, ragging is a cognizable criminal offence and is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the College/University, the concerned student shall be given the liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the College/University will expel him from the relevant programme as well as the campus. As per the Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Ordinance '2009' "Ragging" means any act, conduct, or practice by which the dominant power of senior students, former students, or outsiders, is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior by other students and includes individual or collective act or practices which Involves physical or collective act or practices which:

- Violate the status, dignity, and honor of such students; or
- Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem; or
- Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures, and obscene behavior.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Ragging is a cognizable offence under the law and the punishments to be meted out have to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent. It may include:

- Suspension from attending the classes
- Individual or collective fines
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarships, fellowships, and other benefits
- Cancellation of admission, suspension, rustication, or expulsion from the University/Hostel.
- Withholding results
- FIR with the police and arrest
- More severe punishments were justified such as fines/imprisonment etc.
- Collective punishment may be imposed where involved persons are not identified.

Issue of Mark Sheet/Grade Certificate/Transcript:

- (i) Based on the grades earned, a **Grade Certificate** shall be issued to all the registered students by the University after every semester and a consolidated Marksheet/Grade Certificate indicating the performance in all semesters. The Grade Certificate will display the course details (code, title of the paper, number of credits, grade secured) along with SGPA of each semester and CGPA earned based on each academic year.
- (ii) Letter Grades calculation shall be as per formula provided for all the undergraduate courses as provided in the Ordinance except that the formula for calculating the final percentage of marks will be as follows:-



RAGGING UNDERTAKING BY THE STUDENT AND THE GUARDIAN With reference to HP Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Ordinance No. 1 of 2009

As per the Supreme Court judgment in Vishwa Jagriti Mission vs. Central Government and Others (2001) 6 SCC 577, ragging is a cognizable offence and is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the university, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the University will expel her/him from the relevant program as well as the campus.

As per the Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) ordinance '2009, "Ragging" "means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power of senior students, former students or outsiders, is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practices which-

- 1. involve physical or psychological assault or threat or use of force or wrongful confinement or restraint; or
- 2. violate the status, dignity and honour of such students; or
- 3. expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem; or
- 4. Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gesture and obscene behavior.

Prohibition of Ragging

- 1. No person shall practice ragging in any form, within or outside the premises of an educational institution.
- 2. Any person who indulged in ragging, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to fifty thousand rupees or both.

Checking and reporting of incidents of Ragging

- 1. The University is bound to take immediate action on the occurrence of any incident of ragging. The concerned officer-in-charge will make a report to this effect to the Vice-Chancellor at the earliest.
- 2. Every single incident of ragging where the victim or his/her parents or guardian or the Head of educational institutions is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, a First Information Report (FIR) shall be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- 3. Any failure on the part of institutional authority or negligence or deliberate delay in lodging the First Information Report with the local police shall be constructed to be an act of culpable negligence on the part of the institutional authority.
- 4. If any victim or his/her parents or guardian intends to file First Information Report directly with the police that shall not absolve the institutional authority from the requirement of filing the First Information Report.
- 5. Any person found negligent in taking action/ or shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees, or with both.

Offences to be cognizable, non-bail able or compoundable

- 6. Every offence under this ordinance shall be cognizable, non-bail able and compoundable with the permission of the court.
- 7. (i) Any student convicted of an offence under this ordinance shall be expelled from the educational institution.
 - (ii)Student expelled on account of ragging shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such expulsion.

Preliminary Enquiry/ Action

Place: Baru Sahib

- 8. (i) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parents or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution or an officer-in-charge makes a complaint, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within twenty-four hours of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into it and, if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student found guilty.
 - (ii) Where, on enquiry by the head of educational institution, it is proved that prima facie there is no substance in the complaint received; he shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant.

I have read all the anti-ragging rules as given above in the application form for admission. I am fully aware of the anti-ragging policy of the state of Himachal Pradesh and that of the ruling given by the Honourable Supreme Court of India. I undertake to abide by these rules and regulations to the best of my knowledge and belief. I solemnly affirm that I will not commit any act of ragging on the campus and outside the university. If I fail to do so, on any account, the university may take appropriate action and award any punishment as contemplated above.


