## **Code of Conduct for Teachers**

- 1. All faculty members should work within the university policies and practices so as to meets the vision and mission of the university.
- 2. During the service period, all teachers shall employ themselves honestly and efficiently under the guidance of the head of the institution.
- 3. Any member of the teaching staff should not be engage in any political activity within the university campus.
- 4. Each faculty member should prepare a lesson and/or teaching plan, well in advance before commencement of the lecture or practical laboratory.
- 5. All the teaching staff members must be punctual for classes and should adhere to the timings scheduled for other activities and events.
- All members of teaching staff must do punch regularly in the biometric machine for their attendance which has to be maintained by the IT department and account section collaboratively.
- 7. The duties assigned to teachers include delivering of lectures/ tutorials/ practical's as per the workload distribution of the concerned teacher.
- 8. In addition, teachers have the responsibilities of evaluation and invigilation, administrative work, mentorship, providing guidance to students and participating in extra-curricular activities and university support activities as required.
- 9. The working hours of the teachers will be according to the prescribed time table and other additional duties assigned to them.
- 10. Mentor-Mentee system must be followed by every teacher. Moreover, the teachers should take proper care of their group of students by monitoring, guiding, motivating, and counseling them.
- 11. Faculty members will deal impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, economic, social and physical identity.
- 12. All teachers will act in any manner that violates the morality or decorum within the university campus.
- 13. Abstain from undertaking any other employment and commitment including coaching classes and private tuitions those may interfere with their professional responsibilities.
- 14. Teaching staff must take leave as per rules with prior information, keeping in view their particular responsibility for completion as per the academic schedule.

- 15. Teachers should involve in research and extension activities for their professional growth along with the quality enrichment of the university.
- 16. Teachers should express their opinion by partaking at professional meetings, conferences, seminars etc. towards the knowledge exchange.
- 17. Teaching staff should respect the right and dignity of the student in expressing his/her opinion.
- 18. Teaching staff should encourage students to develop their personalities, improve their attainments and contribute to community welfare.
- 19. Teachers should try to inculcate scientific outlook, respect for physical labour, ideals of democracy, patriotism and peace among students.
- 20. Teachers should abstain from stirring students against other students, colleagues or administration.
- 21. Teachers must abstain from any form of unlawful discrimination relating to gender/sexuality/age/marital status in their behavior towards their colleagues, other teaching staff and students.
- 22. Teaching staff members shall abstain from verbal, non-verbal and/or physical misconduct of a sexual nature in their interactions with students, other university staff members and the university visitors. The university has a zero-tolerance policy towards sexual harassment.
