#### **Brief report**

In a testament to the power of collective vision and perseverance, Eternal University and Akal Academy in partnership with the Women Entrepreneurship Platform (WEP) and with support of Niti Ayog, Govt. of India convened an inspirational event amidst the serene environs of Baru Sahib, Himachal Pradesh. This gathering served as a light of hope and possibility, illuminating the path towards empowerment for women entrepreneurs across India. It is with the wealth of ideas by the wealth of nation- 'the Women,' who walks the walk of every life, nurture the nature of life and illuminates the innate beauty in and around.



With our commitment to support women entrepreneurs, Eternal University has established the Center of Excellence (COE) in Entrepreneurship and Innovation, alongside accelerating the setup of an Atal Community Incubation Centre (ACIC) under the Atal Innovation Mission, Niti Ayog, Government of India. Facilitated by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) and a 4,000 square feet allocation on campus, the inaugural workshop with the Women Entrepreneurs Network took place on May 13, 2024. Additionally, the WEP Nodal Centre for Himachal Pradesh is slated to be established at Eternal University, Baru Sahib. These efforts aim to nurture a conducive ecosystem within the Akal Network, uplifting 20,000 women socially and economically in Himachal Pradesh.
