The Pre-Conference Hands-On Workshop on *Social Entrepreneurship & Change-Making* was held as a precursor to the main conference at Eternal University. This event was designed to empower students with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to drive social change through agricultural entrepreneurial ventures. The workshop aimed to foster a deep understanding of how innovative solutions can address pressing social challenges, particularly in sectors such as the environment and agriculture.

Objectives

• To introduce the concept of social entrepreneurship and its impact on society.

• To engage participants in practical activities that allow them to explore social issues and

develop innovative solutions.

• To foster collaboration between students and industry experts to build a community of

change-makers.

• To provide a platform for participants to network and gain valuable insights from

established social entrepreneurs.

Workshop Structure

Opening Ceremony

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr. Sushma Sharma, Ms. Avantika Pathania, who welcomed all participants and emphasized the importance of social entrepreneurship in the contemporary world. The keynote speaker, **Mr. Amit Tuteja** and **Ms. Medha Dhagat**, from Connecting Dreams Foundation, an expert in the field of social entrepreneurship, presented a thought-provoking session on how businesses can be designed to create both social and economic value. The speaker highlighted the growing relevance of sustainable and socially responsible practices in today's Agribusiness environment.

Session 1: Introduction to Social Entrepreneurship

In this session, participants were introduced to the fundamentals of social entrepreneurship. The speaker elaborated on the differences between traditional entrepreneurship and social entrepreneurship, focusing on how social enterprises create value that benefits both society and the economy. Real-world examples of successful social enterprises were shared to demonstrate the impact of entrepreneurial ventures on social issues, including education, healthcare, and environmental conservation.

Key topics included:

- The role of social entrepreneurship in solving societal challenges.
- The key characteristics of successful social entrepreneurs.
- The importance of balancing profit with social impact.

Session 2: Identifying Social Problems and Developing Solutions

This session was a hands-on, interactive workshop in which participants worked in small groups to identify an agricultural-based social issue they were passionate about. They were tasked with brainstorming innovative solutions that could be turned into sustainable social enterprises. Facilitators provided guidance on how to approach problem-solving, assess feasibility, and identify potential stakeholders.

Participants were encouraged to consider:

- Local and global social challenges.
- The role of technology in solving agricultural-based social issues.
- How to engage communities and stakeholders in the development of solutions.

Session 3: Building a Social Enterprise Model

In this session, participants learned how to transform their ideas into structured social enterprises using the *Business Model Canvas* framework. The facilitators guided students through the process of identifying key aspects of a social enterprise, such as value proposition, customer segments, revenue models, and social impact metrics.

Key learning outcomes:

- Creating a clear value proposition that addresses a social need.
- Identifying potential revenue streams while maintaining social goals.
- Ensuring sustainability and scalability of the enterprise.

Session 4: Pitching and Feedback

At the end of the workshop, each group was asked to present their social enterprise ideas in the form of a pitch. The presentations were followed by feedback. The feedback session provided valuable insights on how to refine business models, address potential challenges, and enhance social impact.
