Brief report of activity

The event was conducted on 23/11/2024 at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Bhanog, Rajgarh, Dist. Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh.

Overview:

knowledge and skills to improve their personal and environmental health. It also fostered awareness about safety and self-care, empowering them to make informed decisions.
