Minutes of Meeting

1. The meeting commenced with a welcome address by **Prof. (Dr.) T. S. Banipal** who introduced the agenda and emphasized the significance of continued innovation and entrepreneurship in the academic ecosystem. **Dr. Naresh Kumar** delivered a PowerPoint presentation showcasing the mission, vision and accomplishments of EU-IIC during the current session.
2. **Dr. Naresh Kumar** gave a comprehensive report on the activities conducted during **Quarter 1 and Quarter 2**, covering innovation awareness programs, student ideation events and entrepreneurial workshops. He appreciated the collective effort and support from faculty coordinators and student members.
3. **Mr. T. Muthukumaran** acknowledged the enthusiasm of faculty and students and attributed the successful execution of IIC activities to collaborative teamwork. He encouraged exploring new formats and themes for future engagements.



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4. **Prof. (Dr.) T. S. 6. **Dr. Hemant Dasila** provided guidelines on capturing and submitting **geo-tagged photographs** of events and emphasized compliance with IIC documentation protocols.
7. **Dr. Nasib Singh** encouraged all departments to contribute actively toward achieving a **3-star or 4-star rating** on the IIC portal. He emphasized the significance of quality, quantity and visibility in institutional activities.
8. **Mr. Muthukumaran** suggested exploring synergies with ongoing university-level initiatives and integrating innovation components into existing student projects and research.
9. **Members** brainstormed on broadening the scope of innovation activities, suggesting increased collaboration with local industries, organizing entrepreneurship bootcamps and fostering student startups.
