

About the Eternal University

Eternal University, established under Himachal Pradesh Government Act No. 3 of 2009, is a visionary initiative of His Holiness Baba Iqbal Singh Ji, who emphasized blending modern scientific education with spiritual values. Inspired by Sant Baba Attar Singh Ji and Sant Teja Singh Ji, Baba Iqbal Singh Ji laid the foundation of the first Akal Academy in 1986, now a network of 130 CBSE-affiliated academies across six states and two universities. Recognized by UGC, AICTE, NAAC, and other esteemed bodies, the university offers a variety of accredited programs, including its ICAR-approved B.Sc. (Hons.) agriculture degree. It is the first private university in Himachal Pradesh to establish a College of Agriculture, College of Nursing, and Centre of Public Health. The serene, pollution-free, fully residential campus provides holistic development opportunities through academics, co-curricular activities, and spiritual education, serving as a modern Gurukul exclusively for girls. The university actively promotes academic excellence by organizing national and international conferences, workshops, and *Kisan Melas*. It also arranges expert lectures and faculty development programs. Eternal University comprises seven constituent colleges fostering value-based education from nursery to Ph.D.

Akal College of Economics, Commerce and Management

The college established in 2011 with the Department of Economics and Management, later added the Department of Commerce in 2013. Its mission focuses on delivering programs aligned with NEP 2020, blending contextual curriculum, experiential learning, and assessments to enhance critical thinking, research, and professional ethics. The college emphasizes leadership development through value-based education, enriched by seminars, workshops, industrial visits, internships, and guest lectures. The Department of Economics offers B.Sc. (Hons with Research), M.Sc. Economics, M.Sc. (Ag.) Agricultural Economics and Ph. D. Economics. The Department of Commerce provides B.Com (Hons with Research), M.Com, and Ph.D. in Commerce. The Department of Management offers BBA (Hons with Research), MBA (Finance, HR, Marketing and Business Analytics) and Ph.D. in Management. The MBA (Business Analytics) is running in collaboration with Virginia Commonwealth University and the University of North Carolina. Faculty from international business schools also contribute to the program.

The Seminar

The seminar focuses on fostering innovations and entrepreneurship to address the unique challenges of rural development in the North-Western region of India, encompassing Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Ladakh, Jammu & Kashmir, and adjoining hilly areas of Punjab and Haryana. Agriculture serves as the backbone for over 80% of the rural population in this region, where the majority of farmers are smallholders or marginal, facing economic vulnerabilities, limited market access, and fragile ecosystems.

This seminar will explore how agricultural and rural innovations can transform agrohorti-livestock systems, enabling sustainability, competitiveness, and resilience in the face of climate change, resource depletion, and shifting market dynamics. By focusing on themes such as climate-resilient technologies, value chain management, entrepreneurship, and sustainable development, the seminar aims to promote diversified income sources, enhance rural livelihoods, and contribute to achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Through a multi-stakeholder approach, involving researchers, policymakers, entrepreneurs, and the farming community, the seminar seeks to create actionable strategies for leveraging the region's resources and capacities for sustainable growth and rural prosperity.

Guidelines for Extended Abstracts/ Full Paper Submission


- ❖ The abstract should be typed in Times New Roman font size 11 with bold title and headings. The theme should be mentioned on the top of the page. Title (10-15 words); Keywords (4-5 words alphabetically); Introduction (upto 100 words max.); Material and methods (100-150 words max.); Results and Conclusion (Upto 150 words). The extended abstract cum summary word limit will be up to 500 words.
- ❖ The abstract/paper should be submitted in word doc only (no PDF will be accepted).
- ❖ The allowed word limit for the invited paper is between 5000 to 6000 words (including abstract, keywords, and references).
- ❖ It should be submitted by email to seminar 2024@eternal university.edu.in latest by 10th March, 2025.
